Code of Conduct

In addition to the positive conduct that Little League® expects of all of its participants, Penns Valley Little League (PVLL) baseball has identified some specific guidelines for conduct that it fully expects all participants to adhere to at all times. Failure to abide by this Code of Conduct could result in action taken by the PVLL baseball Board of Directors against any individual in violation of any of the following guidelines:

1. Good sportsmanship shall be displayed by all participants at all times.
2. All participants shall be respectful of all other participants.
3. At the conclusion of every game, the Players, Managers, and Coaches of each team shall pass through a line congratulating one another on their efforts.
4. Parents and/or Guardians shall do their best to have the Players to practice and games on time in support of the Managers and Coaches. When situations arise that make this impossible, the Parent or Guardian shall inform the Manager of the situation.
5. All Parents, Guardians and Spectators should respectfully allow the Managers of the participating teams to coach the Players during a game. This is not to discourage anyone from encouraging the Players, but it is more intended at discouraging specific statements that could possibly go against what the Manager is attempting to teach. Normal cheering for the Players is a positive thing to do.
6. Negative comments should not be directed at any Player, Manager, Coach, Umpire or Spectator at any time.
7. The use of online media, such as Facebook, Twitter, etc., to negatively talk about Players, Coaches or any members of PVLL is prohibited.
8. The use of any tobacco products or alcohol is strictly forbidden at all PVLL facilities.
9. The use of profanity by a Player, Manager, Coach or Spectator is not permitted. The use of profanity will result in immediate removal.
10. Proper order and discipline shall be maintained by all participants at all times. Loud, rude behavior or any physical confrontation, such as pushing or hitting, is not permitted.
11. Players, Managers, and Coaches are the only individuals allowed in the dugout during a game.
12. No food items are allowed in the dugout during a game. Items like bubble gum, sunflower seeds and water are permissible, but food items like hamburgers, hot dogs and ice cream are not permitted.
13. Players are expected to remain in the dugout during the game.
